# Introduction (1)

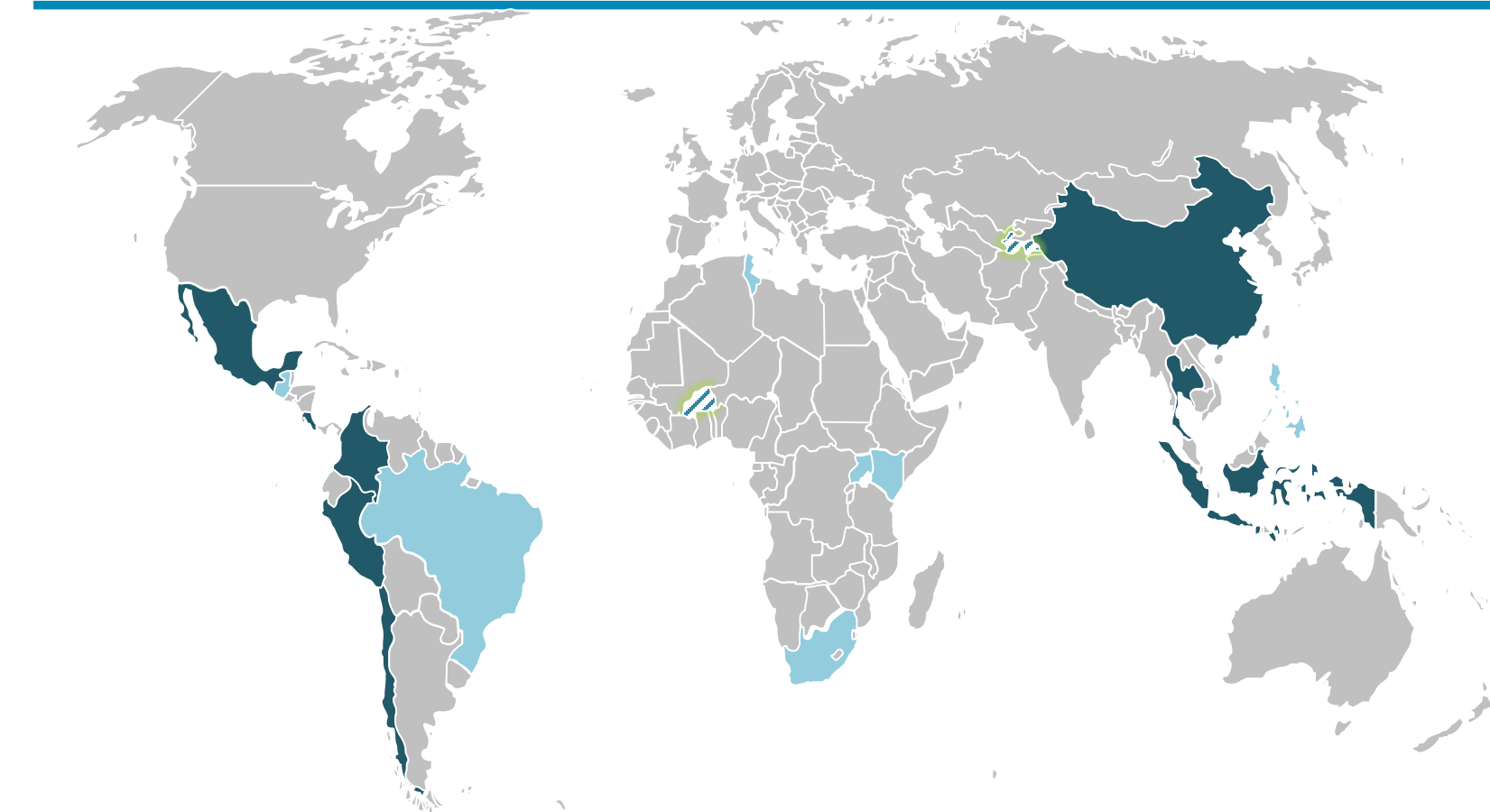

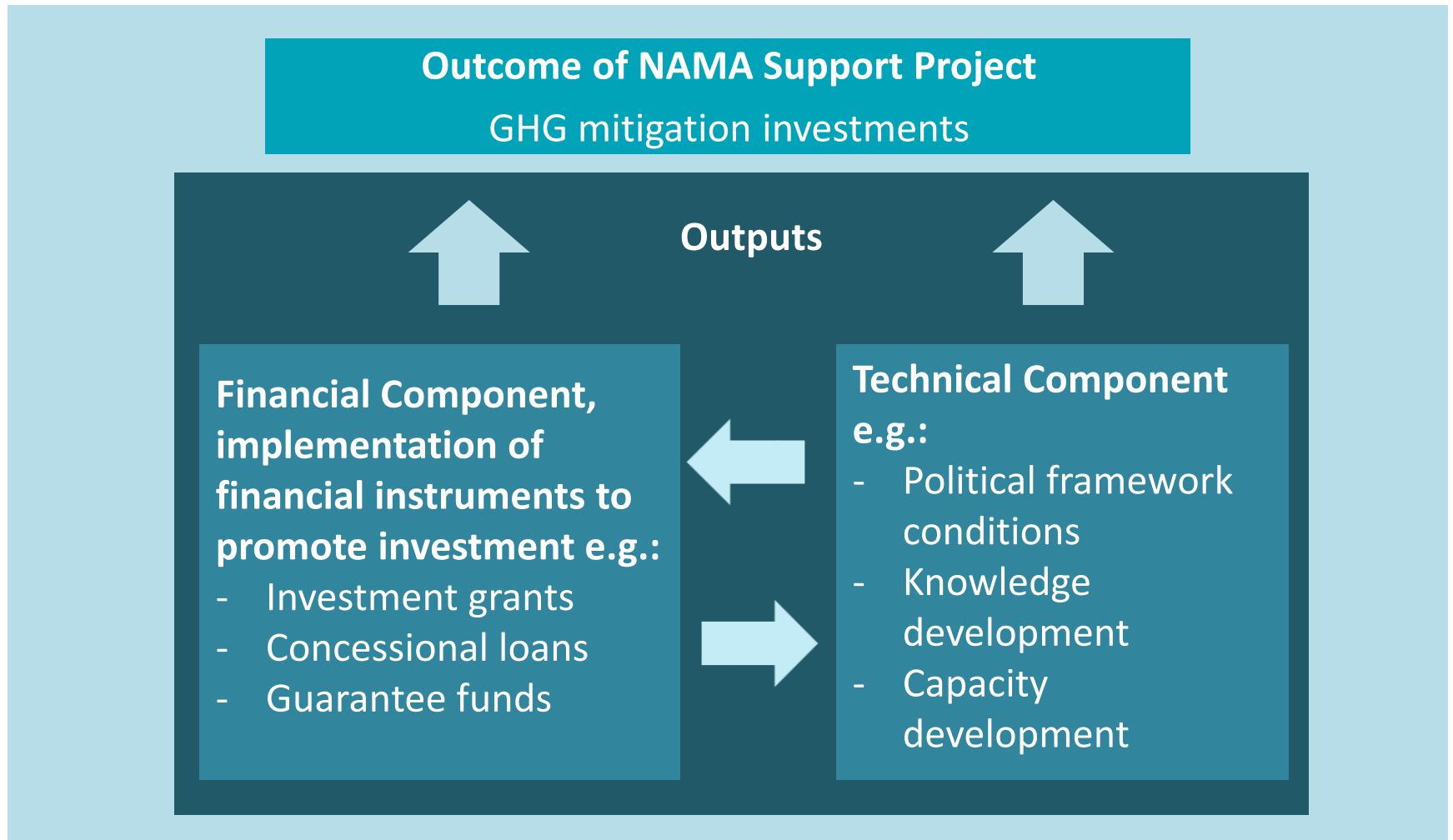

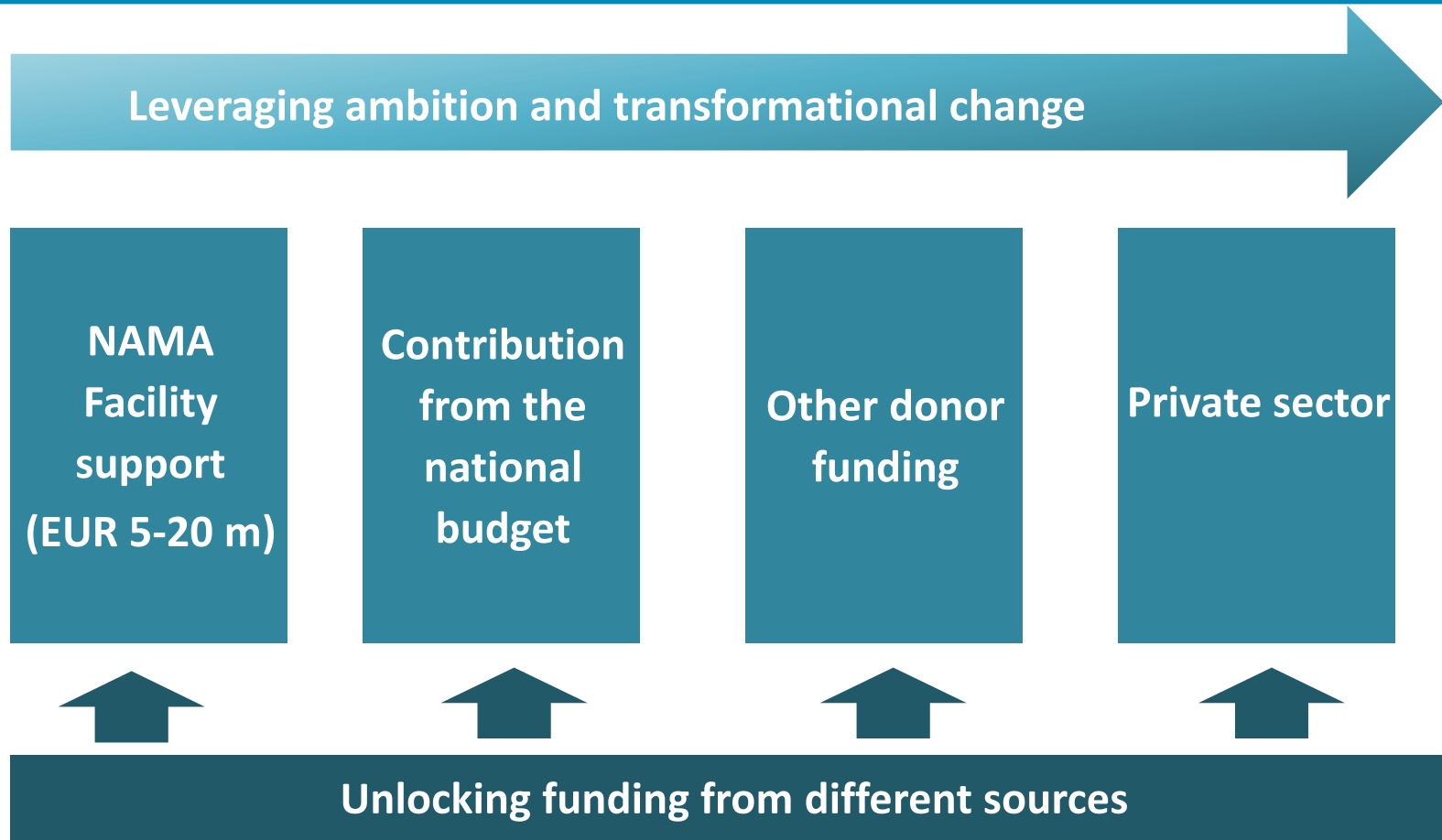

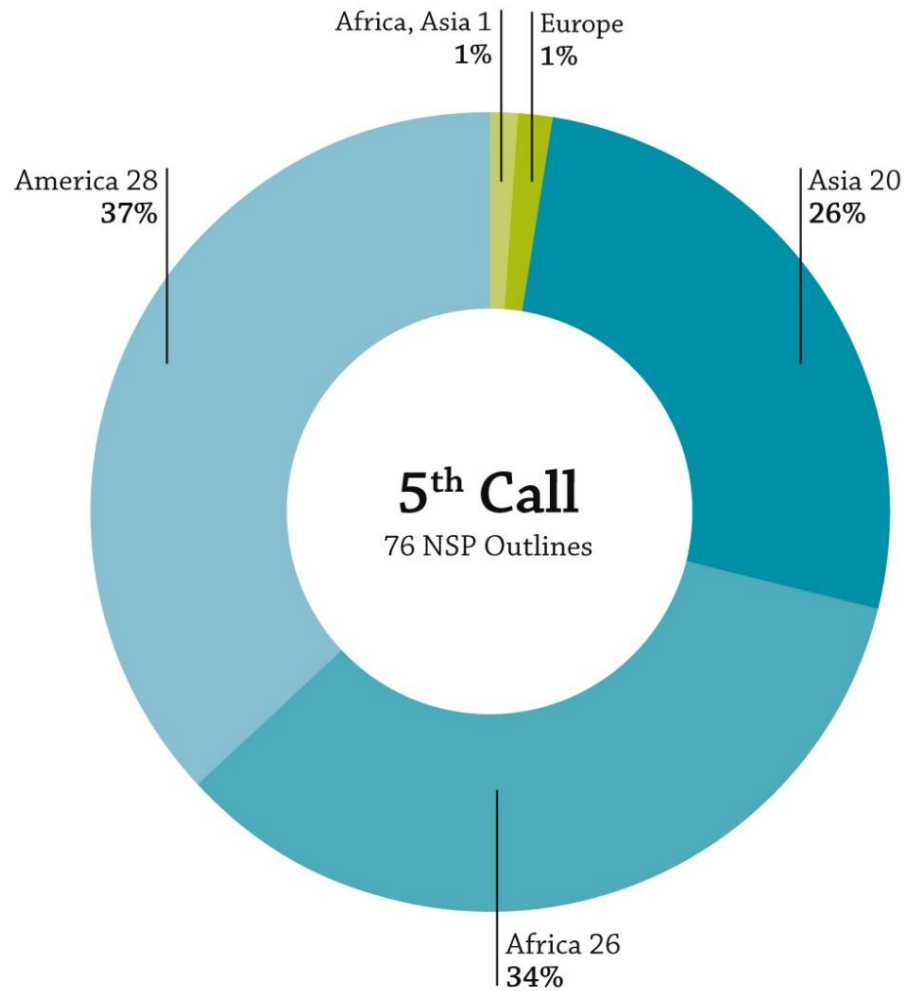

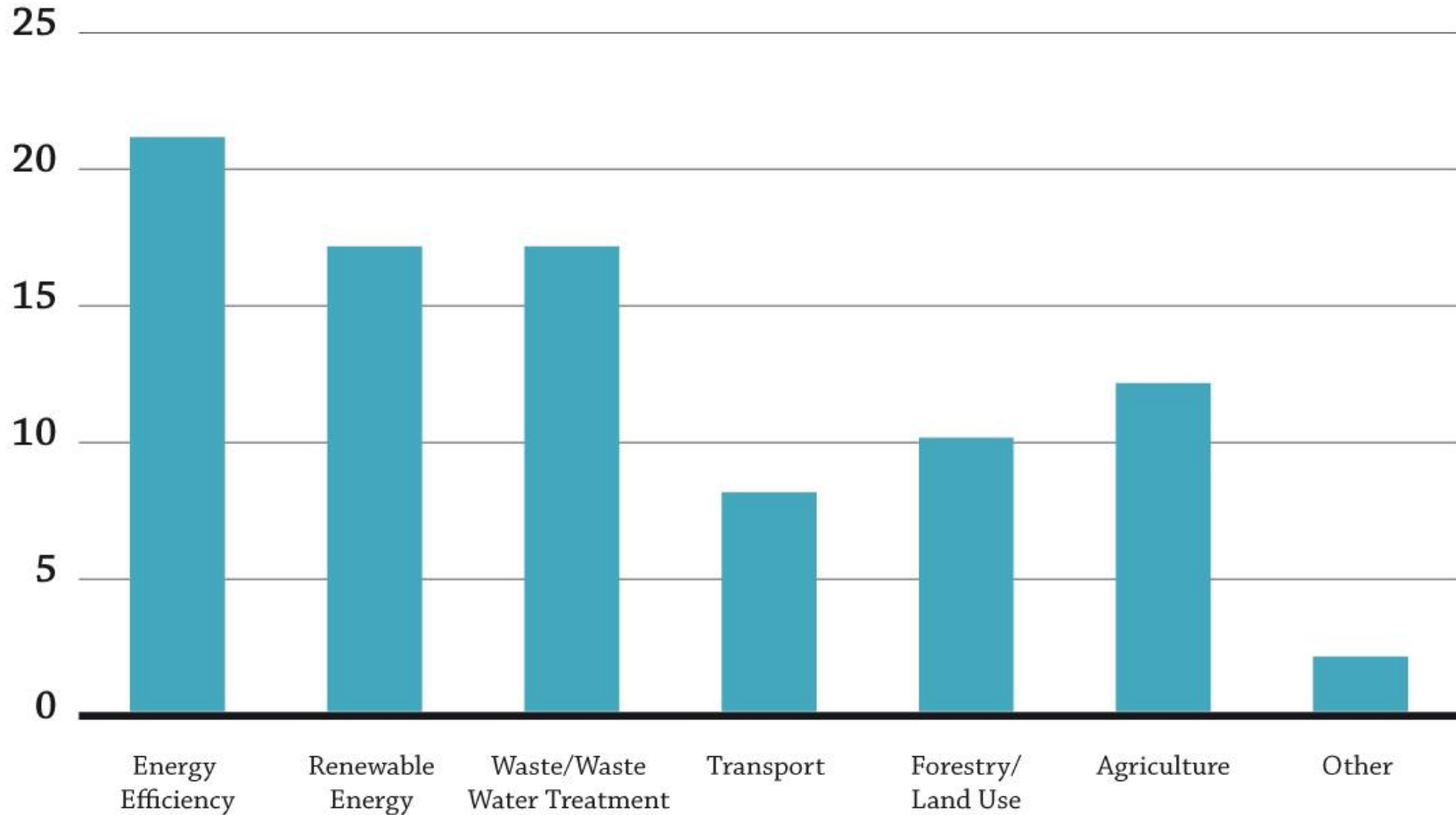
# 5<sup>th</sup> Call Outlines – regional spread

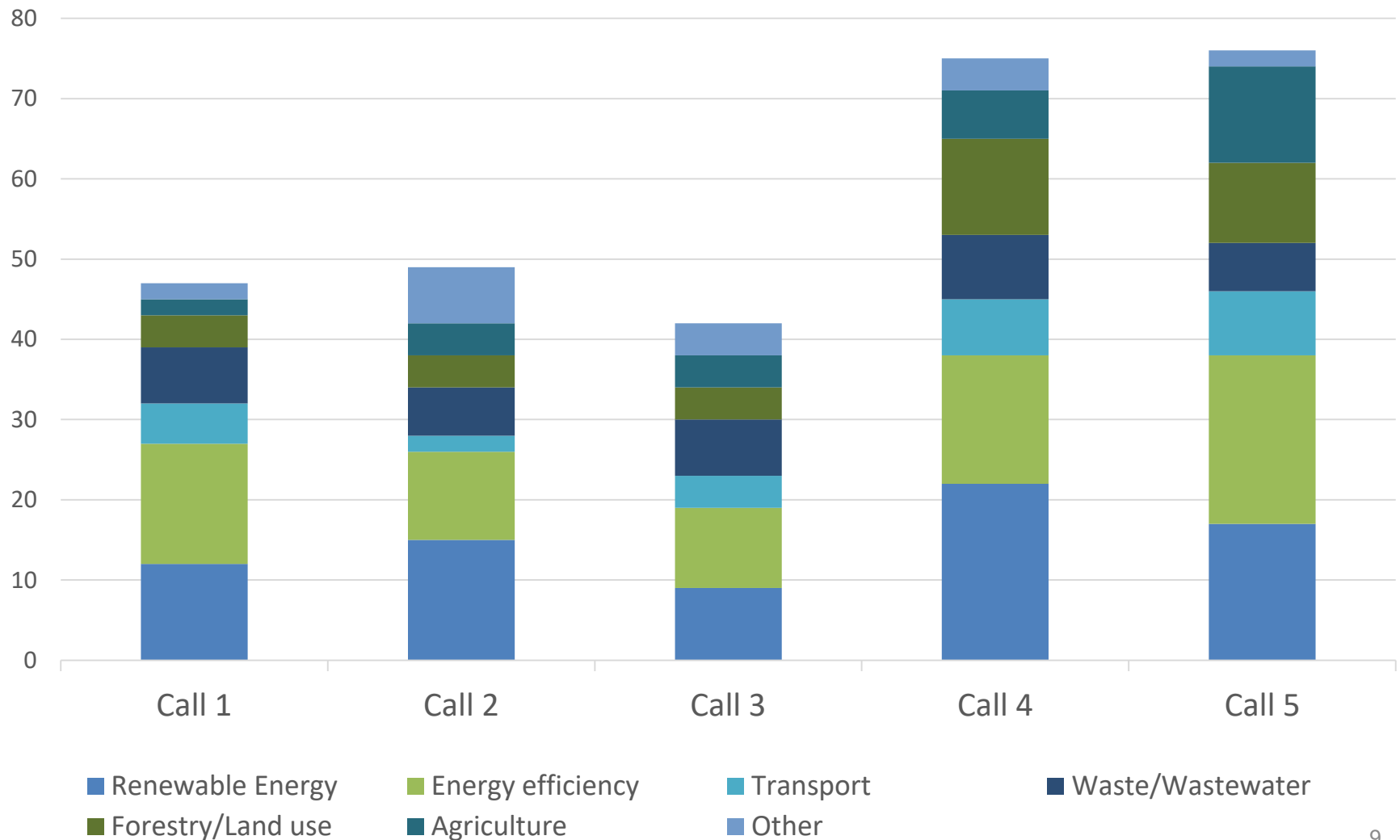
# 5<sup>th</sup> Call Outlines – sectoral spread
